(1) QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS CONCERNING SALVATION Hebrews 6:9 But, beloved, we are persuaded better things of you, and **things that accompany salvation**, though we thus speak.

1.If I believe that Jesus is the Christ, am I saved?

Philippians 1:29 For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, **not** only to believe on him, but also to suffer for his sake;

2. How are Believers Saved by Faith?

II Peter 1:5-9 And beside this, giving all diligence, **add to your faith virtue**; and to virtue **knowledge**; ⁶ And to knowledge **temperance**; and to temperance **patience**; and to patience **godliness**; ⁷ And to godliness **brotherly kindness**; and to brotherly kindness **charity**. ⁸ For **if these things be in you, and abound, they make** *you that ye shall* **neither** *be* **barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge** of our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁹ But **he that lacketh these things is blind,** and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

3. Can we be saved by faith without charity?

I Corinthians 13:2 And though I have *the gift of* prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; **and though I have all faith**, **so that I could remove mountains**, and have not charity, I **am nothing**.

4. What is charity?

Colossian 3:14 And above all these things *put on* charity, which is the bond of perfectness. Which mean, (The guarantee of perfectness, the assurance of perfectness.)

5. What does it mean to be saved by grace?

Ephesian 2:8 For **by grace are ye saved through faith;** and that not of yourselves: *it is* the gift of God: Titus 2:11 For **the grace of God** that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men, ¹² **Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and**

worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;

6. Can we be saved by Faith without works? Read the following,

James 2:14,17 What *doth it* profit, my brethren, **though a man say he hath faith, and have not works? can faith save him?** ¹⁷ Even so **faith, if it hath not works, is dead, being alone. Matthew 16:27** For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then **he shall reward every man according to his works. Read also, Rev.20:12-13**

7.Must every believer receive the Holy Ghost?

Romans 8:9 But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now **if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.**

I Corinthian 3:16 Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and *that* **the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?**

John 15:4 Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.

John 15:10 If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.

I John 3:24 And he that keepeth his commandments dwelleth in him, and he in him. And hereby we know that he abideth in us, by the Spirit which he hath given us.

8. Must Believers live free from sin?

John 8: 36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

I John 3:9 Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he **cannot sin**, because he is born of God. ¹⁰ In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother.

9. What is sin?

I John 5: 17 All unrighteousness is sin: and there is a sin not unto death.

10. What is the sin not unto death?It is a forgivable sin.(3)

11.How can we know the difference between the children of God, and the children of the devil?

I John 3:8,10 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

¹⁰ In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God, neither he that loveth not his brother.

12. Do we have to belong to a Church to be saved?

Acts 2:47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And **the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.**

Ephesians 5:24 Therefore **as the church is subject unto Christ**, so *let* the wives *be* to their own husbands in every thing. ²⁵ Husbands, love your wives, **even as Christ also loved the church**, **and gave himself for it;** ²⁶ That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, ²⁷ That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

Colossian 1:18 And **he is the head of the body, the church:** who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all *things* he might have the preeminence.

II Corinthians 12:12 For as **the body is one**, and hath many members, and **all the members of that one body**, being many, **are one body:** so also *is* Christ. ¹³ **For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body**, whether *we be* Jews or Gentiles , whether *we be* bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit. ¹⁴ For the body is not one member, but many. ¹⁵ If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body? ¹⁶ And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body? 13. Since the scriptures indicate one Church, how can someone seeking for The Church Identify it?

It is a sanctified Church. sanctified and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, Eph. 5:26 (4)

It is an Holy Church. it should be Holy and without blemish. Eph. 5:27

It is named the House of God:

Genesis 28:17 And Jacob awaked out of his sleep, and he said, Surely **the LORD is in this place;** and I knew *it* not. ¹⁷ And he was afraid, and said, How dreadful *is* this place! **this is none other but the house of God, and this** *is* **the gate of heaven.**

I Kings 5:5 And, behold, I purpose to build an house unto the **name** of the LORD my God, as the LORD spake unto David my father, saying, Thy son, whom I will set upon thy throne in thy room, he shall build an house unto my name.

Ephesians 3:14-15 For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁵ Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,

JOHN 17:11 And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, **keep through thine own name** those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we *are*.

THE CHURCH IS THE PILLAR AND GROUND OF THE TRUTH I Timothy 3:15 But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.

SAINTS MUST WORSHIP GOD IN TRUTH St. John 4:24 God *is* a Spirit: and **they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.**

WE MUST BE SANCTIFIED BY THE TRUTH

John 17-17,19 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. ¹⁸ As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world. ¹⁹ And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth.
