James 4:14-15 **Whereas ye know not what *shall be* on the morrow. For what *is* your life?** It is even a vapour, that **appeareth for a little time, and then vanisheth away.** For that ye *ought* to say, **If the Lord will,** we shall live, and do this, or that.

Ecclesiastes 6:12 For who knoweth what *is* good for man in *this* life, **all the days of his vain life which he spendeth as a shadow?** for who can tell a man what shall be after him under the sun?

Job 9:25 Now my days are swifter than a post: they flee away, they see no good. They are passed away as the swift ships: as the eagle *that* hasteth to the prey.

DAVID PRAYED TO GOD;
Remember how short my time is: wherefore hast thou made all men in vain? **What man *is he that* liveth, and shall not see death?** shall he deliver his soul from the hand of the grave? Selah.

Psa.89:47-48

Psalms 103: 15-16 **As for man, his days *are* as grass: as a flower of the field, so he flourisheth. For the wind passeth over it, and it is**

gone; and the place thereof shall know it no more.

WE ARE NOT WISE, WHEN WE US TIME UNWISELY. JESUS SAID;

Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away. **But of that day and *that* hour knoweth no man,** no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father.

Take ye heed, watch and pray: for ye know not when the time is. Mark 13:31

When time is no more, then there is ETERNITY.

THE RULE FOR USING TIME WISELY, IS ONE DAY AT A TIME.

We should never put off today for tomorrow, for tomorrow for us, may never come.

Jesus said to a man, Follow me. But he said, Lord, suffer me first to go and bury my father. Jesus said unto him, Let the dead bury their dead: but go thou and preach the kingdom of God. And another also said, **Lord, I will follow thee; but let me first go bid them farewell, which are at home at my house. Luke 9:60-61**

In other words: I got people at home, I can't follow you right now. Give me some time.

Then there are the ones that make excuses because of other

personal reasons. Notice the following.

Acts 24: 24-25 And after certain days, when Felix came with his wife Drusilla, which was a Jewess, **he sent for Paul, and heard him concerning the faith in Christ.** And as he reasoned of righteousness, temperance, and judgment to come, **Felix trembled,** and answered, **Go thy way for this time; when I have a convenient season, I will call for thee.**

The word touched his heart, and he harden his heart, and asked for more **time.**

OUR DAILY PRAYER SHOULD BE:

Psalms 90:12 So **teach us to number our days,** that we may apply *our* hearts unto wisdom.

Ephesians 5:15 -16 See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise, ¹⁶ **Redeeming the time,** because the days are evil. ¹⁷ Wherefore be ye not unwise, but **understanding what the will of the Lord is.**

Colossians 4:5 Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, **redeeming the time.**

Live one day at a time. don't try to manage tomorrow. we don't have tomorrow, but we have now, today. Use time wisely.

II Corith 6:2 (For he saith, I have heard thee in a **time accepted,** and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, **now is the accepted time;** behold, **now is the day of salvation.**

Do you know that today is all we have, let us do today the things that need to be done. We may not see tomorrow.

Do we owe some body an apology? We better pay that debt today, tomorrow might be to late.

Is there any thing in our lives that we need to get strait? We better get it done today, tomorrow might be to late.

Do what you need to do today, and leave the future in God's hand. Remembering that all we have is now, and make the best of it, If we fail to do what needs to be done while there is time, you need to know that it cannot be done in **eternity.**

There is **no end to eternity,** **time** has an end, **but eternity will never end.** Therefore we better make preparation in **time,** so that we will not spend eternity in the wrong place. There is only two ways in **eternity,** that is **heaven,** and **hell.** Which way will you go?
